Sealed proposals will be received by the: City of Greensburg of Westmoreland County at 416 S. Main Street, Greensburg, PA 15601 **until 1:15 p.m. on, Tuesday, June 2, 2009** to be opened and read at 1:30 p.m. on June 2, 2009 in Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 416 S. Main Street, Greensburg, PA 15601, at which time any interested person is invited to attend. Said proposals shall be acted upon at the regularly scheduled City Council Meeting held in Council Chambers at 7:00 p.m. on Monday, June 8, 2009, for the following:

- Mill city streets
- Resurface city streets with approximately:
  - 18,151 Sq. Yd. Milling (Depth 0" to 3") various lengths and widths.
  - 1,085 Tons Superpave Asphalt 9.5 mm PG 64-22 Wearing Course 0 to 0.3 million ESAL's, SRL H, 1 1/2" depth.
  - 560 Tons Superpave Asphalt 9.5 mm PG 64-22 Leveling Course 0 to 0.3 million ESAL's, SRL H, 1/2" to 3/4" compacted in place.

Liquidated damages apply at the rate of \$200.00 per calendar day. Proposals must be upon the forms furnished by the City of Greensburg. Said forms may be picked up Monday through Friday from 8:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. at the City Administration Office, 416 S. Main Street, Greensburg, PA, upon the deposit of **\$50.00 non-refundable fee**. The bid must be accompanied by a certified check or **bid bond in the amount of 10% of the bid**, made payable to the City of Greensburg. A performance bond or certified check in the amount of 100% of the contract shall be furnished by the successful bidder within 20 days after the contract is awarded. Also, a 2-year maintenance bond is required with this project.

**Prevailing wage rates do apply to this project with the exception of 2,417 Sq. Yd. of the Milling on Harrison Avenue and Ehalt Street of to which Federal Davis-Bacon wage rates will apply. In the portion of the project subject to the Davis-Bacon Wage Act, workers must be paid not less than the prevailing minimum wages as established by the US Department of Labor as shown in the applicable wage decision included with the Bid Documents. For this portion of the project, notice is hereby given that this is a Section 3 project of the Housing and Urban Development Act of 1968.
