

FAQ's -Your Property in the City of Greensburg

If you're embarking on new home improvement projects, the following guidelines set forth by the City's Code Enforcement Office are to keep our neighborhoods attractive and inviting and may be useful in your property maintenance efforts:

- Grass shall not exceed 6" in height.
- Garbage is not to be placed out for pickup until the night before service.
- Unlicensed vehicles or vehicles with expired inspection stickers are not permitted to be parked on property or streets.
- It is unlawful to burn within the City of Greensburg.
- Daily maintenance and the repair and construction of curbs and sidewalks are the responsibility of the property owner.
- Plumbing work must be done by a registered plumber. A list of registered plumbers is available in the Code Enforcement Department.

When Is a Building Permit Required?
