

PUBLIC NOTICE

Please take notice that the following entitled Bills were introduced at the regular Council meeting of Greensburg City Council on the 14th day of February 2011:

Bill No. 4 - AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF GREENSBURG AMENDING CHAPTER 127, ENTITLED 'CERTIFICATES, LICENSES AND PERMITS' OF ORDINANCE NO. 1646, THE CODE OF THE CITY OF GREENSBURG. The purpose of the introduction is to incorporate the more stringent standards and the regulations of PA Act 106 of 2010 amending the 1945 Public Eating and Drinking Place Act and the 1994 Food Act.

Bill No. 5 - AN ORDINANCE AMENDING CHAPTER 151 ENTITLED 'FEES' OF ORDINANCE NO. 1646, THE CODE OF THE CITY OF GREENSBURG. The purpose of Bill No. 5 is establish fees to be charged in conjunction with the licensing and inspection of retail food facilities in the City by the City's Health Inspector that are affected by Act 106 of 2010 in the amount of \$35 for a temporary license, \$60 for a permanent license, \$125 for the 2nd re-inspection and \$175 for the 3rd re-inspection or more; and to add a new fee under Recreation of \$20 for referee training.

Please take further notice that the above-entitled Bills shall be considered by Mayor and Council for final enactment and adoption as ordinances at the regular City Council meeting on March 14, 2011, at 7:00 p.m., in Council Chambers, 2nd Floor, City Hall, 416 S. Main Street, Greensburg, PA, at which time any interested person will be given an opportunity to be heard.
